Overview

Are there electrical outlets in Kazakhstan?

No, the electrical outlets in Kazakhstan are different from those in the United States. In Kazakhstan electrical outlets of types C & F are used, while the United States has electrical outlets of types A & B. Do I need a travel adapter for Kazakhstan?

The electrical outlets and power plugs in Kazakhstan are of types C & F (see images).

What type of plugs does Kazakhstan use?

Kazakhstan uses power outlets and plugs of types C & F. Take a look at the pictures below to see what these plugs and power sockets look like: Doesn't look familiar?

Do the outlets look different in your country?

You'll need a power plug adapter. Type C - The standard European plug.

Do I need a travel adapter in Kazakhstan?

The electrical outlets and power plugs in Kazakhstan are of types C & F (see images). If your country uses the same electrical outlets and power plugs, you don't need a travel adapter. However, you may still need a voltage converter if the voltage is different.

Do I need a voltage converter in Kazakhstan?

If your device or power adapter is not dual voltage or you are unsure, and the voltage and/or frequency in Kazakhstan differs from your own country, you should use a voltage converter when plugging in your devices and power adapters in Kazakhstan. What power plug types and electrical outlets are used in Astana?



What voltage does Kazakhstan use?

Also, the voltage in Kazakhstan is the same as in Europe. What Outlet does Kazakhstan Use?

Type C plug sockets are used in Europe, Africa and Asia. They have two round pins and no grounding pin. These plugs are typically used with devices that have a voltage of 220-240V. This outlet is rated for 2.5 amps.

Does Kazakhstan have a plug and socket system?

Like most of its neighbouring countries Russia, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan and Kyrgyzstan, Kazakhstan has standardized on the German plug and socket system. What is the mains voltage in Kazakhstan?

The voltage in Kazakhstan is 230 volts and the frequency is 50 Hz. Kazakhstan has standardized on type C and type F sockets and plugs.
