


Which telecommunications company has the most base stations in Uganda

Orange Uganda now turned Africell, cannot definitely compete with MTN and Airtel when it comes to 2G coverage, but what they miss to cover in 2G technology they make up for it in 3G. Data being the company's cash cow, Orange invested heavily in 3G technology leading the industry. They single-handedly managed to push the competition.

This is what I would call an 'on the down-low' network. With no public coverage map to share on their website, it is a hit a miss getting to know the actual extent of their mobile network coverage. UTL has both 2G and 3G networks with an LTE network coming soon. They claim to cover most parts of Uganda with voice, data and SMS services.

With rumors of supporting voice (VoIP) in the near future, (not be confused with VoLTE also known as Voice over LTE) services they badly need to expand their.


